**Tony Corroto (Acworth)** Tony Corroto was a Senior Police Officer with the Atlanta Police Department. For fourteen years he was assigned to the DUI Task Force. He specializes as a Standardized Field Sobriety Testing instructor as well as a Drug Recognition Expert instructor. He is also an instructor for the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration and has taught DUI enforcement at both the Atlanta Police Academy and the Georgia Public Safety Training Center. Mr. Corroto is an "on call" expert witness for the State of Georgia. He has been recognized as an expert witness on over 2,300 DUI cases for the City of Atlanta in one year alone.

**Katherine "Trina" Griffiths (Atlanta)** has worked at the law firm of Stein & Ward, LLP for the past four and a half years. Prior to that she prosecuted in the Cobb County Solicitor's Office for over a decade. After receiving her Juris Doctor degree from Mercer Law School in Macon, Trina practiced civil law for a few years in the Atlanta area and clerked for two Cobb County Superior Court judges in the early 1990s.

**Mike Hawkins (Atlanta)** B.A. University of Alabama, 1989. J.D. Emory University, 1992. Mr. Hawkins served as a DUI prosecutor in metro Atlanta for 5 years before entering private practice. He is recognized by the American Bar Association as Board Certified in DUI Defense through the National College for DUI Defense (NCDD). In 2008, he was elected to the Board of Regents for the NCDD. He is a frequent lecturer in Georgia and nationally on DUI issues. He serves as Vice-Chairman of the DUI Committee for the National Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers (NACDL) and served locally as President of the DeKalb Bar Association.

**Marny Heit (Atlanta)** is a solo practitioner who has spent over 10 years specializing in the defense of DUI and other traffic-related offenses. She is also Of Counsel to The Bernstein Firm. Marny has been selected as a Super Lawyers Magazine Rising Star in the area of DUI Defense for the last 5 years. She is a graduate of the Emory University School of Law, and received her undergraduate degree from Syracuse University.

**Dr. Jimmie Valentine (Americus)** served as Professor of Pediatrics, Pharmacology, and Myeloma Research at the U. of Arkansas School of Medicine and was a faculty member at the U. of Missouri-Kansas City School of Medicine and Oral Roberts U. School of Medicine where he served as Professor and Chairman of Pharmacology. At all the academic institutions where he served as a faculty member he also directed certified Toxicology laboratories and had active research programs in the fields of drugs of abuse, performing and developing analytical techniques for determining drugs of abuse, and correlating levels found in humans with behavioral effects. Dr. Valentine is Board certified in applied clinical pharmacology and as a forensic examiner. He has been qualified as an expert witness in a number of states.

**Rusty Wright (Cordele)** has practiced criminal defense for the past 30 years. He has been Board Certified in Criminal Law by the National Board of Trial Advocacy since 1986. A past and current Vice President of the Georgia Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers, he has been named to the Georgia Superlawyers list for the past 3 years.
