Dear Mr. Martinez:

The Office of the Registrar at The University of Toledo is in receipt of your Subpoena for the educational records of Rick Anthony Swope. Federal law, specifically the Family Educational Right to Privacy Act, 20 U.S.C. 1232g(b)(2), requires either a signed release from the student or former student or a lawfully issued subpoena or judicial order. The subpoena or order must be issued out of an Ohio court or the federal court for the Northern District of Ohio, Western Division. Upon receiving the subpoena or court order, the University must notify the student or former student and give him or her a reasonable time to respond before it can release the records. The University's policy is to release the records ten (10) days after mailing notice to the student or former student. It will expedite procedures in our office if you will immediately provide us with a current address of the student or former student.

Alternatively, if you provide a release signed by the student or former student, it should specifically request his or her educational records and should have the student's or former student's social security number. We request the original signed document rather than a copy.

In addition, our office never received your first request. Please submit further correspondence to The University of Toledo addressed to the Registrar's Office. 
Thank you for your letter dated 7/27/99 in which you requested verification of the following two questions:

CLASS SCHEDULES

Class schedule information is not part of the Directory Information and will not be given over the phone.

DEAN'S LIST

Full-time students (12 or more earned hours and 12 or more quality graded A through F) who earn a 3.5 or above GPA for the term are on the Dean's List. Grades of PS do not count towards the Dean's List.

The Dean's List is not available in the Summer term.

The Dean's List is posted on the transcript at the end of each term which was earned.

Some area newspapers publish the Dean's List, however, students' names are subject to directory restrictions set on their record.

DEAN'S RECOGNITION LIST

Part-time students are eligible for Dean's Recognition List for the year's performance.

Students must be enrolled for both semesters of an academic year of 9 to 22 hours graded A through F between the two semesters.

Students must be enrolled part-time for the academic year.

Students must earn a GPA of 3.5 or better for each semester.

Dean's Recognition List is posted on the transcript at the end of the term in which the award was earned.

DECEASED STUDENTS

The Dean of Students Office is responsible for notifying certain University officials of the death of currently enrolled students and of students who have been enrolled more than one academic year. Notice for those who are out of school for more than one academic year normally comes from family members or other University officials. Notification must include documentation of the death; e.g., copy of death certificate.

ENROLLMENT VERIFICATIONS

Student enrollment verifications are processed through the National Clearinghouse and in person.

GPA CALCULATION

The cumulative grade point average (GPA) is determined by dividing the total number of quality points earned into the total number of quality hours. Repeated courses that have not been approved for deletion are included in the calculation.

Multiply the grade value for each course by the number of quality hours to determine the quality points.

Add the total quality hours and quality points.

Divide the total quality points by the total quality hours to determine the GPA.
